
First Prize

Best Mentor in Health Research Award



Introduction

- an award given every 2 years to recognize and reward mentors in health research who have built the capacities of researchers in the health sector
- it recognizes excellence in mentorship that instills passion among researchers, redounding to enhanced relevance and productivity in health research.



Who are qualified to be nominated?

- 1. a Filipino citizen
- 2. at least a holder of master's degree
- 3. actively involved in mentoring researchers/students or colleagues for at least 5 years
- 4. has a good track record as a researcher in terms of publication, product development or policy formulation
- 5. professionally involved in health research activities either as a research program/project leader, principal and co-principal investigator, mentor/adviser/trainer, or author/co-author
- 6. actively involved in health research activities such as conduct of research training and extension work, paper presentations, fund generation, research promotion and networking, research agenda setting, and capacity-building activities

Winners are ineligible for subsequent nominations.



Selection Process

All nominations including those from non-members of the consortium, should be submitted to the consortium secretariat

The consortium will check the completeness of the documents and will shortlist the nominees.

Shortlisted nominees should be endorsed by the chair of the consortium and must be submitted to DOST-PCHRD

The Cluster Selection Committees for Luzon, Visayas, Mindanao, and NCR will convene to review, validate and select the Cluster Winners from the nominees.

The profile of Cluster Winners from Luzon, Visayas, Mindanao, and NCR shall be submitted to the National Selection Committee for further evaluation.

The National Selection Committee shall choose one National Winnerfrom the Cluster Winners

Alberto G. Romualdez, Jr. Outstanding Health **Research Award** (AROHRA)

Introduction

- Given every three(3) years by the Department of Science and Technology- Philippine Council for Health Research and Development (DOST-PCHRD) in collaboration with the Department of Health (DOH)
- gives recognition to a research program or project that has demonstrated the link between research and practice through the utilization of research findings in the health delivery system
- encourages researchers to be sensitive to the scientific and technological requirements of the health delivery system and rewards those whose research have contributed significantly to addressing prevalent health issues





Categories



Biomedical Research Health Services



1. Biomedical Research Category

the program or project must be engaged in generating and/or adapting appropriate health technologies that address specific health problems and emphasize the development of diagnostic tools and techniques, biological (e.g. drugs, vaccines, functional foods, etc.), biomedical devices, and ICT-based healthcare technologies



2. Health Services Research

the program or project must be involved in the organization, administration, operation, utilization and other aspects of health services delivery systems that address the country's social, political, cultural, and economic conditions.

Nomination Procedure

How to nominate?

- Nomination should be made using the prescribed nomination form and should be endorsed by the Chair of the consortium
- Each nomination should include all of the following:
 - Write-up on the impact of the project on health delivery
 - One copy of each of the technical reports and/or publications
 - Statement from the technology user(s) and program or project end-user
- After the preliminary screening, the judges may ask for additional supporting documents from the nominees.

Incentives



The Award consists of a cash prize of P 500,000 and a trophy for winners of each category.
